

**ARK-LA-TEX PAINT HORSE CLUB
AWARDS RULES FOR SHOWS
2011**

Points for all awards will be awarded on a 6-5-4-3-2-1 basis depending on the number of entries in the class. Tiebreaker will be most 1sts, 2nds, etc. – a tiebreaker judge will be drawn if not broken by placements.

EXHIBITORS MUST DECLARE THAT THEY ARE GOING FOR HI-POINT AWARDS AND SIGN UP AT THE SHOW SECRETARY'S DESK

To Qualify for Hi-Points

Ark-La-Tex Paint Horse Club Hi Point: Open Performance Horse; Open SPB; Youth Walk Trot; Novice Youth; Youth 13 & Under; Youth 14-18; Amateur Walk Trot; Novice Amateur; Amateur, PAINT FOR A DAY

The hi-point horse will be the cumulative score of all judges.

No ALTPHC or Color classes will count for hi-point.

To Qualify for the ALTPHC Hi-Point:

Open Horse Open SPB Horse and Paint For a Day a horse must be shown in 3 open, SPB or PFAD performance classes **and** the respective open, SPB or PFAD halter class and may be shown by more than one exhibitor.

Youth 13 & Under & Youth 14-18 , the youth must show in any 3 youth performance classes **and** youth mares or youth geldings – 1 horse–1 exhibitor - – if different ex. in each division, halter points are required and go with the ex. showing in halter and not required in the other division.

Youth Walk-Trot the youth must show in 3 youth walk-trot classes. Youth mares or youth geldings will count for points if shown but is not mandatory – 1 horse-1 exhibitor.

Novice Youth must show in 3 novice youth performance classes. Youth mares or youth geldings will count for points if shown but is not mandatory - 1 horse – 1 exhibitor

Amateur, the amateur must show in any 3 amateur performance classes **and** amateur mares, stallions or geldings - 1 horse - 1 exhibitor.

Amateur Walk Trot, Novice Amateur, the novice must show in any 3 novice am or 3 Am Walk-Trot performance classes. Amateur mares, stallions or geldings will count for points if shown but is not mandatory - 1 horse - 1 exhibitor.
